In front of MOD Lookout 9.10.08 – masses of shingle lower down the beach – not used for re-shingling



Accumulated Shingle Ridges lower down on beach – not re-used for emergency works to re-shingle  
Given that it costs £60.00 per cubic metre to bring in new shingle from Bretts (Quarry) – what a waste!



How easy it would be to bulldoze material back up the beach from where it originally washed down from.
