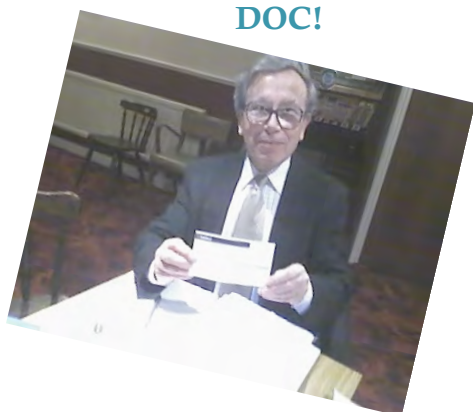

## EA/Sea Defence Update

DOC has been busy meeting up with various EA Staff to discuss progress on the Folkestone to Cliff End Scheme and we are delighted to report that DOC will form part of a local Stakeholders Board for Broomhill involved at first hand during the Design/Planning stages of this section.. Our Technical Officer Tony Hills will have a direct input on behalf of our members with Halcrow (EA Consultants) who are managing the project. Various workshops are planned during 2009/10 to finalise the design work. Emergency works for Littlestone sea defences are due to start this month and the overall scheme for the Littlestone section is now at the design stage. The second stage for Dymchurch is also about to commence and DOC is keeping a watchful eye on how this will affect the local community. The time scale of all these planned works is very important and DOC continues to pressure for the schemes to be implemented as soon as possible.
